2. Location of Cemetery

PERMINTAH DAERAH KHOSUS
IBU KOTA JAKARTA
DINAS PERMAKAMAN.

Proceed to Kebayoran Lama towards the Bogor Road intersection until you see the above sign on the right hand side of the road. Turn right and proceed along this road for approximately one half of a mile. Continue past the Muslim Cemetery administration block which is located on the right hand side of the road, for about 100 yards, until you see a sign also on the right hand side of the road "KRISTAN CEMETERY". Turn into the parking area. Walk across the railway line and the Christian graveyard is to the left.

3. The journey from the Chancery to the Cemetery takes about 20-25 minutes. However, officers attending the Service should allow more time (at least ten minutes) in case there are Muslim funeral processions also proceeding to the Cemetery.
